If you look at it Quickly and Kind of Crooked it looKs like a letter $\mathbf{Q}$. In fact, it sounds like the letter $\mathbf{Q}$, but without the " $u$ " that has to follow it in English. It is the only letter that isn't a final form that goes below the line. QUPH represents the number 100.
