This is the letter **TZADEE SOFIT**: עָדִי סוֹפִית)

IT'S a letter that siTS above and below the line. It's a guy who is waiting to catch the piZZa he spun in the air. It is a shape only found at the end of a word.

It sounds like **TS** or **TZ**. It represents the number 90.

In order to practice a letter that only comes at the end of a word, an \aleph (silent ALEPH) will be at the beginning of each word with each of the vowels.
