This is the letter VET: 】 (בֵית)

It has a bar on the bottom, and a base that goes beyond, just like the letter $\mathfrak{Z}$, but it has a Vacuum or a Void in the Very middle. It represents the number 2 (just like $\mathcal{Z}$ ). It sounds like $\mathbf{V}$.

The $\beth$ (VET) is actually a $\mathfrak{\beth}$ (BET) that comes at the end of a syllable or after a long vowel.
